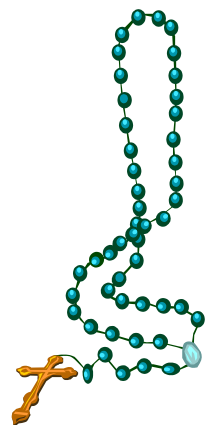

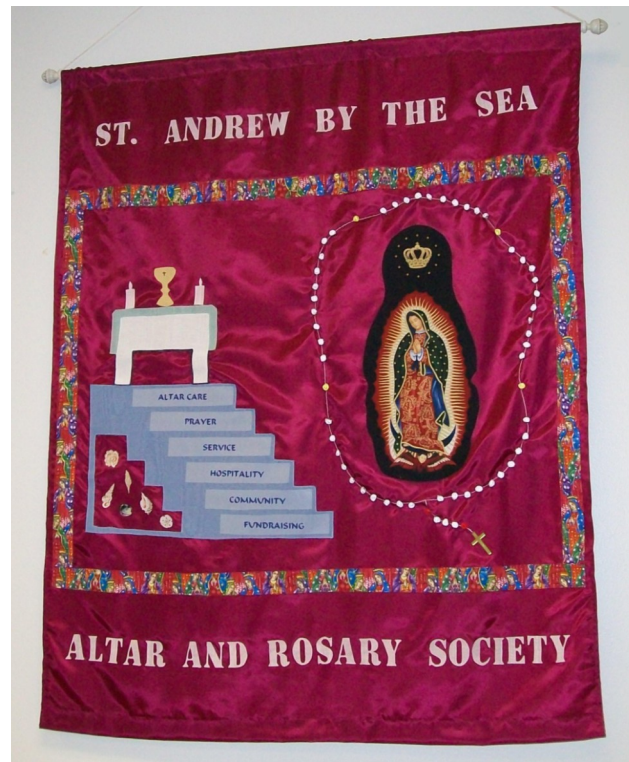

The Giving Tree

Once again it's time for our Giving Tree program. We will be providing gifts for 50 children this year. Each child will have two gift requests. We will have the Giving Tree to distribute the 100 ornaments at all masses the weekend of **Nov. 10th/11th**. The wrapped gifts, including the ornament tag, need to be returned to the church by **Sunday Dec. 2nd**. We will also have a money gift box for those in the parish who would like to help but are unable to purchase a gift. We use this money to purchase gifts for any child whose gift request was not chosen and then use any extra for gift certificates for the family. We will be sorting the returned gifts on **Dec. 2nd** following morning mass. The delivery of the gifts will be Sunday Dec. 9th at noon following 11am mass.

Catholic Charities And Backpack Program

We collect items to help to serve the needs of the local community of Flour Bluff. We will update the list of needs in the bulletin and bulletin board in the FLC. You may bring your donated items to any Mass or drop them off at their location, (Hustlin Hornet Street entrance to St. Paul).
