Three companies were interviewed (Tavco, Gulf Coast, Fecht & Co) with bids received
for rollup and manual aluminum and steel shutters.

Roll up too costly (\$40,000 to \$50,000)

Best bid for aluminum was \$10,350 and \$6,304 for steel

Committee proposed Gulf Coast bid

Motion to approve Gulf Coast for manual steel shutters to be installed at cost of \$6,304
with 1st by Ray Salinas and 2nd by Steve Galvan and approved by all present

Bo Rimar to present proposal to the Finance Committee meeting 2/12/2018 to secure
funding and determine start date

Jerry Whitworth and Bo Rimar to notify Gulf Coast of acceptance of their bid and Tavco
and Fecht & Co their bids not accepted

Hickory Dickory Docks will be obtained to put shutters up in event of a storm.
Neil Brown and members of the Knights of Columbus will take shutters down.
